The Presidents Leadership Award Application

This inaugural scholarship is offered for the first time to a graduating senior, young woman, who is a resident of, or attends high school in, Collin County, Texas. Applicants must have at least a 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale and have at least a score of 19 on the ACT or a score of 980 on the SAT. The ideal applicant must have also applied, and been accepted, to a Historically Black College or University (HBCU). The scholarship award amount of \$2,000 will be distributed directly to the recipient's school, following receipt of proof of enrollment.

A 200-250-word essay, in 12-point font and double spaced, is required as part of the application process. In addition to being a scholar, we are looking for applicants who have shown an interest in their community or school and have taken action to make a difference. The action could have been in support of health-related challenges, issues of economic sufficiency facing women and girls, social justice, or equal rights issues.

Please submit two (2) letters of reference supporting your application and speaking to your leadership ability. At least one letter should be from a teacher, administrator or counselor at your school. Your name should be on each letter and it should be signed by the author, with their contact information for verification. Letters of reference should come under separate cover to: scholarship@pearlsofservice.org.

Completed applications are due no later than May 29, 2021.
